

Nevada Trapper,

Because of Covid-19 safety requirements, please see the following list of instructions and how to proceed, by check-in station, to get bobcat pelts sealed.

In light of COVID-19, the safety of members of the public and NDOW personnel is the highest priority. Nevada Administrative Code requires the physical inspection (check-in) and sealing of bobcats. Physical check-ins may create situations where social distancing could be compromised. Please abide by the following rules when checking in all bobcats:

1. All bobcats presented for sealing must have a completed jaw tag properly filled out and attached to corresponding bobcat jaw, not the pelt.
2. All trappers must have an NDOW bobcat harvest report form completed for all bobcats being presented for sealing. See NDOW website [http://www.ndow.org/Hunt/Seasons\\_and\\_Regulations/Furbearer](http://www.ndow.org/Hunt/Seasons_and_Regulations/Furbearer)
3. If jaw tags or harvest reports are not completed in advance, you will be asked to leave and complete these tasks. You will then have to go to the back of the line to wait your turn.
4. Face masks must be worn, and social distancing (6 feet minimum) is required by all parties at all times.
5. Bobcat sealing (check-ins) will occur outside whenever possible. If weather prevents an outside inspection, one trapper at a time will be allowed inside. Additional members of the party or family will be asked to remain outside.
6. If directed to below, call ahead to the appropriate NDOW office to Schedule your bobcat pelt sealing. NDOW office phone numbers are as follows:
